Brief description of Research Project:

We are looking for RAs who would be interested in helping out research projects that focus on how infants start to learn about race. These projects will examine infants' brain activities using EEG in response to different race people and infants' stranger wariness in response to different race people.

Major Responsibilities of Undergraduate Research Assistant:

RA will help with scheduling participants, data collection (including conducting in-person behavioral/EEG studies and/or leading story times or home visits), assistance in literature review, designing studies, coding data (e.g., coding babies looking patterns or behavioral responses from video stimuli), administrative tasks (e.g., editing video stimuli), and participating in lab meetings.

Prerequisites and Qualifications:

Preference for students who have completed Introductory to Developmental Psychology and Research Methods and have experience interacting with infants, preschoolers, and/or early elementary school age children. Minimum 2 quarter commitment (either Spring and Summer or Spring and Fall). Ability and willingness to drive to make home visits.
