TAKES 5-6 YEARS TO
COMPLETE. IT IS RESEARCH
ORIENTED, BUT YOU CAN
PRACTICE CLINICALLY AS WELL.

PSY.D


PSY.D PROGRAMS TAKE



# SOME EXAMPLES OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE UNIVERSITIES FOR PSY.D/PH.D

"In Graduate schools you will be studying for your Master's or Doctorate in a specific area of study. The courses that you take will all be designed to help you master the field of study that you are majoring in. These courses will build your technical knowledge, but don't focus as intently on applying the knowledge. Graduate schools are more likely to require a thesis prior to graduation." -- Best Masters Degree

# Clinical Psychologist

Someone with a Ph.D or Psy.D, sometimes an EdD in clinical psychology. They diagnose and treat mental and behavioral disorders.

### **Therapist**

Someone with a Masters or Ph.D in counseling or clinical psychology. Their main focus is working 1:1 with patients/clients, treating couples, or leading therapy groups.

## **Psychiatrist**

A medical doctor (M.D.) who often works with patients with mental health issues that often involves drug therapy.

# Social Worker or Counselor

Someone with a a MSW (Masters in Social Work)
They support children and families in need of assistance. They also help people solve and cope with problems in their daily lives.

Usually work in clinics, rehabilitation centers, or in schools. Some positions include: substance abuse, child and family, or military/veteran social workers/counselors.
